

Improvements and new disabled facilities for Christchurch Methodist and United Reformed Church

The parishioners of Christchurch in Thame decided to facilitate greater community use of the church. This required the provision of disability access.

The main works involved Basil Wyatt & Sons Ltd in the remodelling of the Victorian entrance, adjustment of floor levels to include facilities for the disabled, kitchen refurbishment and the insertion of a structural steel frame to create a new upper level meeting room and gallery.

Access to the mezzanine levels is via a feature central staircase and lift, both of which rise within the steel frame.
